

NEW OBELISK IN WARD CEMETERY

Grave markers are usually made of stone or bronze, but the one below is quite unusual. Erected on a split stone base is the wooden marker for George Ward, an early settler of North Sebago who died in 1866. In the late 1970s it was repaired by members of Maple Grove Grange. The Sebago AdHoc Cemetery Committee recently found this wooden marker was in need of repair.

Dave Twombly, a resident of Sebago, constructed a new marker as an exact replica of the existing one. Many thanks to Dave for his dedication to the project and excellent workmanship.

The marker can be located in the Ward Cemetery which is located on Ledgewood Road, which is off Anderson Road.
